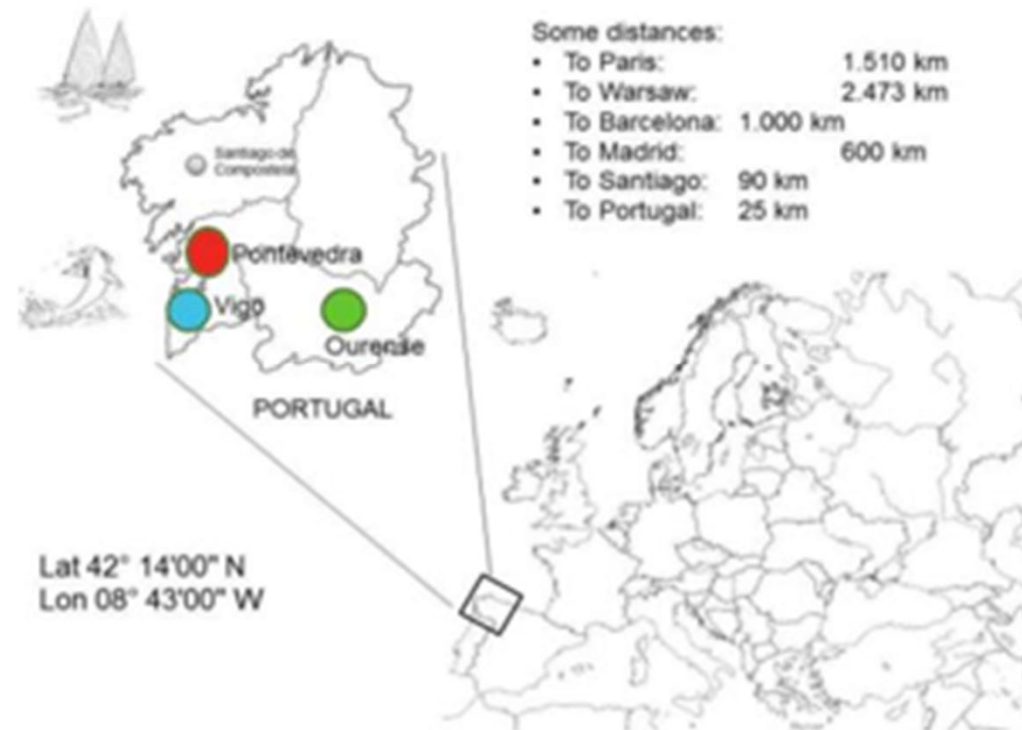

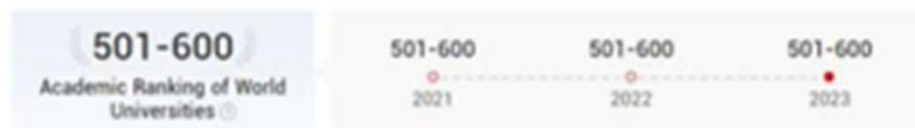

Why a Strategic Plan for Internationalisation?

- Internationalisation = key to quality, competitiveness, sustainability
- Beyond mobility: a university-wide transformation
- Based on participatory diagnostic with 600+ community members
- Aligns teaching, research, services and strategy with global outlook



Internationalisation of Spanish Universities

- Spain: 1st Erasmus+ destination (+60k students) 2021/22
- Spanish: official in 21 countries, 2nd most spoken language (native speakers)
- Spain, 3rd country highest quality of life and one of the safest
